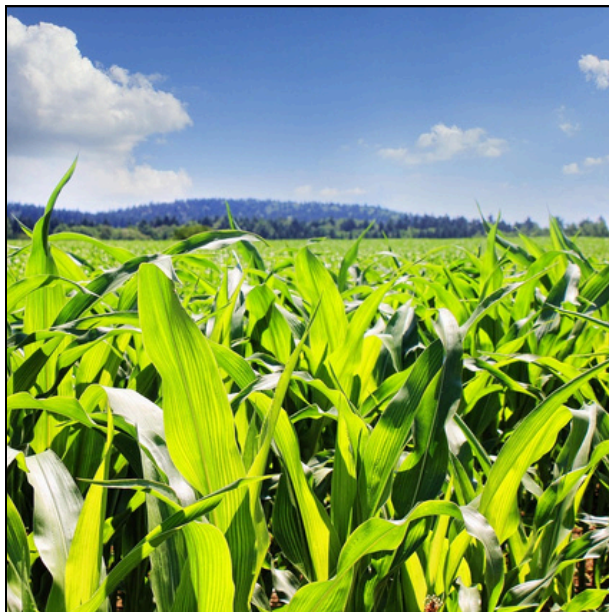

DAIRY CATTLE FARM



- Operate milking systems and equipment
- Monitor livestock health and breeding cycles
- Feed and care for calves
- Move and handle livestock safely
- Keep barns and milking equipment clean
- Help with silage preparation and storage
- Use mini-tractors and feeding equipment
- Do minor repairs and daily maintenance



PIG FARM



- Monitor pig health and reproductive cycles
- Manage feeding and nutrition
- Move pigs between pens/facilities
- Assist with artificial insemination
- Carry out castration procedures
- Clean facilities with pressure washers
- Help with marketing and selling livestock
- Perform routine farm maintenance



POULTRY FARM



- Check flock health and well-being
- Manage feeding and watering systems
- Monitor environmental conditions
- Collect and prepare eggs for sale
- Clean and disinfect buildings
- Assist with general upkeep and small repairs

YOU SHOULD:



- Be hardworking and responsible
- Have a strong interest in agriculture
- Be ready to adapt and learn in a hands-on environment



ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?



EDUCATION



You must be currently enrolled in an **agricultural study program**, and:

- Have completed at least **one semester**
- Be studying a relevant subject such as **veterinary science, animal husbandry, or livestock management**

You must also provide:

- A **study record book** and **references from your university**, showing:
 - Your enrollment date
 - Your expected graduation date
 - Relevant courses in the agricultural field

LANGUAGE



You'll need to prove A2-level English or German skills.

Accepted certifications include:

- IELTS (General Training) score of 3.0
- Cambridge Key English Test (A2)
- TOEFL iBT

Goethe-Institut German certificate

AGE



You must be **between 18 and 29 years old** to apply.

REQUIRED APPLICATION DOCUMENTS



To apply, you must include the following:

YOU SHOULD:

- CV (Curriculum Vitae) with:
- Full name, phone number, and email address
- Full home address
- Marital status (married or not)
- If you have children
- Height (in cm)
- Driver's license (yes/no and what vehicle type)
- Copy of your passport – all pages, including front and back
- Study Record Book + University References
- Must confirm enrollment and expected graduation date
- Must show completion of at least one semester
- Must show relevant agricultural coursework
- Language Test Certificate
- A2 level English or German (IELTS 3.0 / Cambridge KET A2 / TOEFL / Goethe)
- Link to your presentation video
- A short video of yourself, introducing who you are and why you'd be a great candidate for the program



PROGRAM DETAILS



Duration

- Internships last 18 months

Monthly Wages

- First 6 months: **12,800 DKK**
- After 6 months:
 - Under 25 years old: **14,850 DKK**
 - 25 years and older: **17,200 DKK**

Monthly Expenses

- Housing: around **2,000 DKK**
- Food and personal expenses: approx. **2,500 DKK**

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM COST?



TRAVEL



- You'll need to arrange and pay for your own transportation to Denmark.



ADMIN FEE



- There is a 1,500 DKK administration fee. This will be automatically deducted from your first or second month's wages.



APPLICATION PROCESS



All applications (including your video introduction) are stored in our candidate database.
If you meet the requirements, we'll match you with a Danish farm.
Once selected, we'll help you with all paperwork, contracts, and visa documents.
Visa processing takes 2–3 months after documentation is submitted.
If required, we assist with biometric data collection.

WHAT WE HELP WITH



Your 1,500 DKK admin fee covers full support before and during your stay:

When You Arrive in Denmark:

- Help getting your CPR number (Danish ID)
- Biometric appointments (if needed)
- Help registering with SKAT (tax office)
- Help setting up your bank account

These processes can take up to 2–3 months.

WHAT TO EXPECT



1. Know Your Role

Before you begin, make sure you understand what's expected of you. Your responsibilities will be clearly listed in your employment contract. Read it carefully.

2. Where You'll Live

You'll stay close to the farm in shared housing.

- Private room
- Shared kitchen, bathroom, and lounge
- You'll be responsible for keeping things clean
- Approximate rent: 2,000 DKK/month

You'll cook and clean for yourself — share chores fairly with housemates.

3. Working With Others

Respect different cultures, diets, and religions. Many farms are run by women — treat all colleagues with professionalism and open-mindedness. Try not to isolate yourself with people only from your home country.

4. Travel Info

Before you arrive, you must send us:

- Travel date and arrival location
- Names of people traveling with you (if any)
- Your contact information

Must be sent at least 1 week before you arrive

Let us know honestly if you can drive. If you have a license, you can convert it to a Danish one later.

Study Denmark's traffic laws in advance.

5. Communication Is Key

Danish work culture values direct, honest communication.

If you have a problem — speak up! Whether it's about your job, your housing, or your health, talk to the right people:

- Job issues → speak to your employer or colleagues
- Housing problems → talk to your host or housemates
- Program issues → contact your coordinator (Denmark or home country)

6. Money for the First Month

You'll need 200–300 EUR for personal expenses while waiting for your first paycheck.
